- 3-day training workshops are offered once or twice a month.

 - To demonstrate and/or discuss the various steps and timeline of the CLARITY technique, including solution preparation, hydrogel embedding, passive and electrophoretic tissue clearing, and sample imaging.

 - To answer questions and discuss your potential CLARITY applications.
